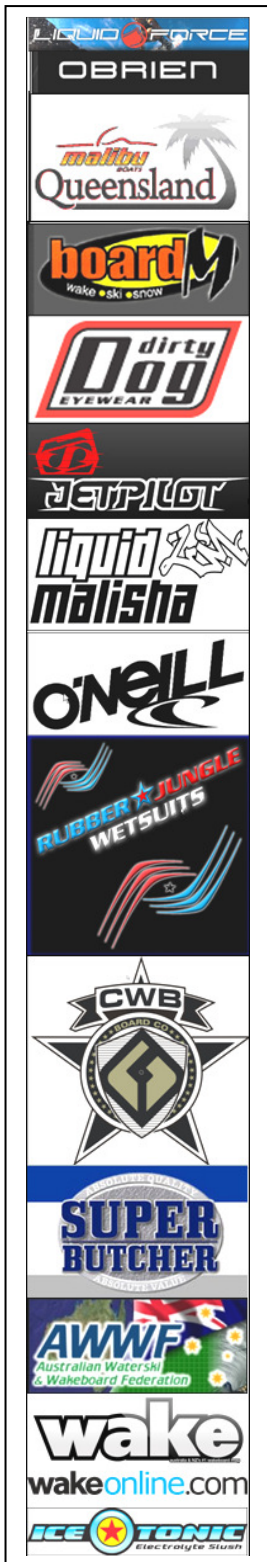

### End of State Titles Wrap Up

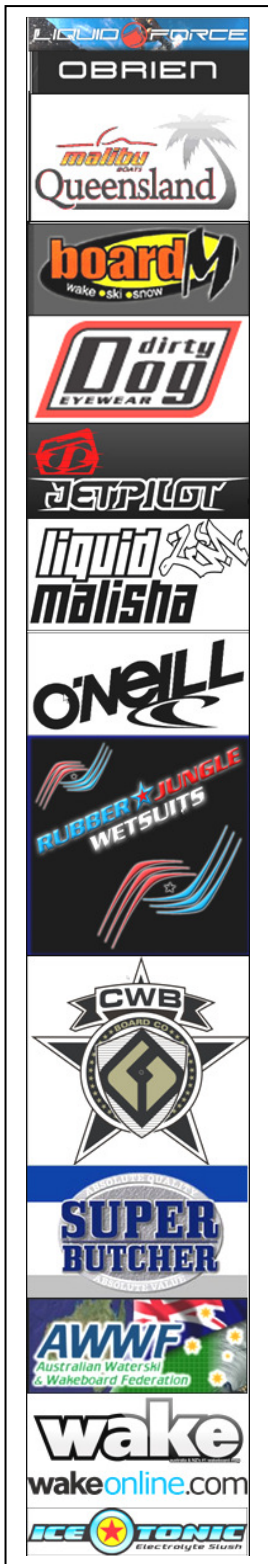
The Season 2009-2010 was wrapped up with a fantastic State Titles on the Gold Coast.



We ran 5 rounds during the year on awesome fresh water lakes like Somerset, Kurwongbah and Joyda and were thrilled to have a lot of new Competitors join us for the season. We operated Competency Based Categories encouraging the ever growing number of Cable Riders in Qld to come and compete behind a boat and that was a huge success. We also trialled Saturday vs Sunday comps to find the right balance and the right way to ensure maximum participation.

We were thrilled to once again have Harley Clifford compete at our events and setting the highest possible benchmark for our Juniors to follow and we also had our youngest ever competitor this season, 4 year old Bailey Hollindale who this weekend completed 3 stand up passes in the State Championships.
